The Imagination Club will focus on a balance of stories and art. Sessions will have a fun combination of literature and hands-on activities. We will explore the world of artists, nature, history, engineering, cultures, and just plain old discovery and conversation. Here is a sampling of some club meetings:

What is a Dragon? - Are dragons real or just make believe? Do they exist today? Participants will learn and discuss how dragons are part of legends while making a fun fire breathing dragon.

Egg-citing Things are in Store for You! We will make a marbled egg and discuss the amazing works of Carl Faberge.

Eric Carle- A quick study on the artist and tissue paper collage of an animal.

Castles- Discussion on castles all over the world with a STEM challenge on engineering the tallest turret.

Pirates Weren't Pretty! - History of pirates and how they are portrayed in our literature and in films. An introduction to N.C. Wyeth and how his paintings shaped how we visualize pirates today. We will create pirate hats to finish the lesson.

Monster Mash Up- Greek Mythology to Modern Day Movies. We will discuss monsters in past and present cultures. Participants will create a whimsical monster figure. This will not be a scary!

Fireworks Go Boom! - The history of how fireworks started. Imagineers will create a magical fireworks painting

Venetian Dr's Masks- Discussion on how medical masks have evolved. Imagineers will create a Venetian styled bird mask.

The Heart of the Matter- SEL lesson on our hearts and feelings. Imagineers will craft an abstract heart painting.

Tall Tales and Silly Stories to Tell in the Bathtub - During Read-a-Thon, we will have a story telling event.

Egyptian Pyramids- What was it like to make a pyramid? A quick journey to ancient Egypt followed by collaborative team building for... "**The Great Pyramid Challenge!**"
