Our students will be going outside on Monday afternoon, April 8th, for the solar eclipse. The district has purchased eclipse sunglasses for our students so they can safely view and participate in this experience. We are expecting the partial eclipse to begin at 12:45 PM, maximum eclipse to begin at 2:03 PM, and the partial eclipse ends at 3:20 PM. We plan to be outside as a school a few minutes prior to and after the maximum eclipse. We will adjust recess times to before and after the partial eclipse on Monday or have indoor recess. We will not be accommodating visitors during the eclipse.

Essential Question: How did the Civil War impact people?

Focusing Question (lessons 16-29) How did the Civil War impact girls and women?

Standards:

- Determine two or more main ideas of a text and explain how they are supported by key details; summarize the text
- Engage effectively in a range of collaborative discussions (one-on-one; in groups, and teacher-led) building on other's ideas and expressing their own clearly.
- Write opinion pieces on topics or text, supporting point of view with reasons and information.

Reading for understanding

- Students will identify the P.O.V. of girls and women during the Civil War
- Analyze how journals and letters were written in first person give more accurate and reliable information of girl's and women's experiences in the war.
- Develop opinions on various topics relating to the Civil War and how it had an impact on their life
- Text features (pictures, captions, headings, graphs, index, table of contents, glossary)
